ELK GROVE, Calif. (January 22, 2025) – Approximately one in five Californians – about 8.8 million – currently struggle with food insecurity*. To help address this critical issue on a local level, Sky River Team Members – along with matching funds by the casino – donated a total of \$3,000 and almost 900 pounds of food to the Elk Grove Food Bank. Team members generously donated to the cause during the recent holiday season, and the much-needed funds and food were donated to the food bank at a time when storage is light after the holidays.
